Leaf Pick-up Policy

Our annual leaf collection program is conducted each October and November. The schedule announcing pick up dates for your location will be posted on the Concord Township website in late September of each calendar year.

Concord Township asks residents to take these steps to help keep leaf collection on schedule, hold costs down, and reduce storm water pollution:

- Rake leaves one foot away from the curb or edge of the street if your neighborhood does not have curbs
- Keep leaves away from storm drains and catch basins because storm water runoff carries them to nearby waterways where they are a source of water pollution. Clogging these areas with leaves also may cause flooding on your property.
- Keep leaf piles free of rocks, branches and other yard waste. Leaf piles found with these materials will not be picked up.
- Place leaves away from obstacles such as mailboxes, fire hydrants and vehicles.
- Avoid parking on or near leaf piles. It's difficult for our crew to operate our leaf equipment around parked vehicles.
