

MINUTES
CONCORD TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES
SPECIAL SESSION
June 22, 2021

The Concord Township Board of Trustees met in Special Session at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, June 22, 2021. Trustee Tom Mercer called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance. Trustees Tom Mercer, Don Pence and Neil Rhoades was present as was Fiscal Officer Bill Whidden.

The meeting was held to meet the requirement for a Public Hearing on the 2022 Tax Budget of the Township. At the board meeting on June 8, 2022 Mr. Whidden provided a draft of the Tax Budget to each Trustee. Mr. Mercer inquired about a number of revenue projections, particularly the significant projected reduction in interest income. Mr. Whidden explained that the interest rate being paid by the Township bank and Star Ohio are at historic lows and are not expected to increase in the near term.

Mr. Whidden explained that the proposed capital expenditures for next year remain the same as 2021 while the source of funding would change slightly based on projected fund balances in each individual fund account. Projections for revenues from gasoline tax and Auto Registration fees are expected to be flat to slightly lower for 2021.
